Thank you for the discussion today. As you know, we have a roof age rule that limits the useful life of a flat roof to 15 years of age. You submitted roof inspection reports earlier this year that substantiated an exception to allow for a single term of remaining useful life, moving the nonrenew date back to 4/30/2023.

With your appeal, and an additional in-depth review of the documents you have submitted, we are willing to allow an additional 2 years remaining useful life for these roofs. From Citizens insurance perspective, this extends the useful life of the roof to 4/30/2025. We will not be able to grant any additional exceptions beyond that date without replacement of the roof coverings.

We will go ahead and make these adjustments in the system.
